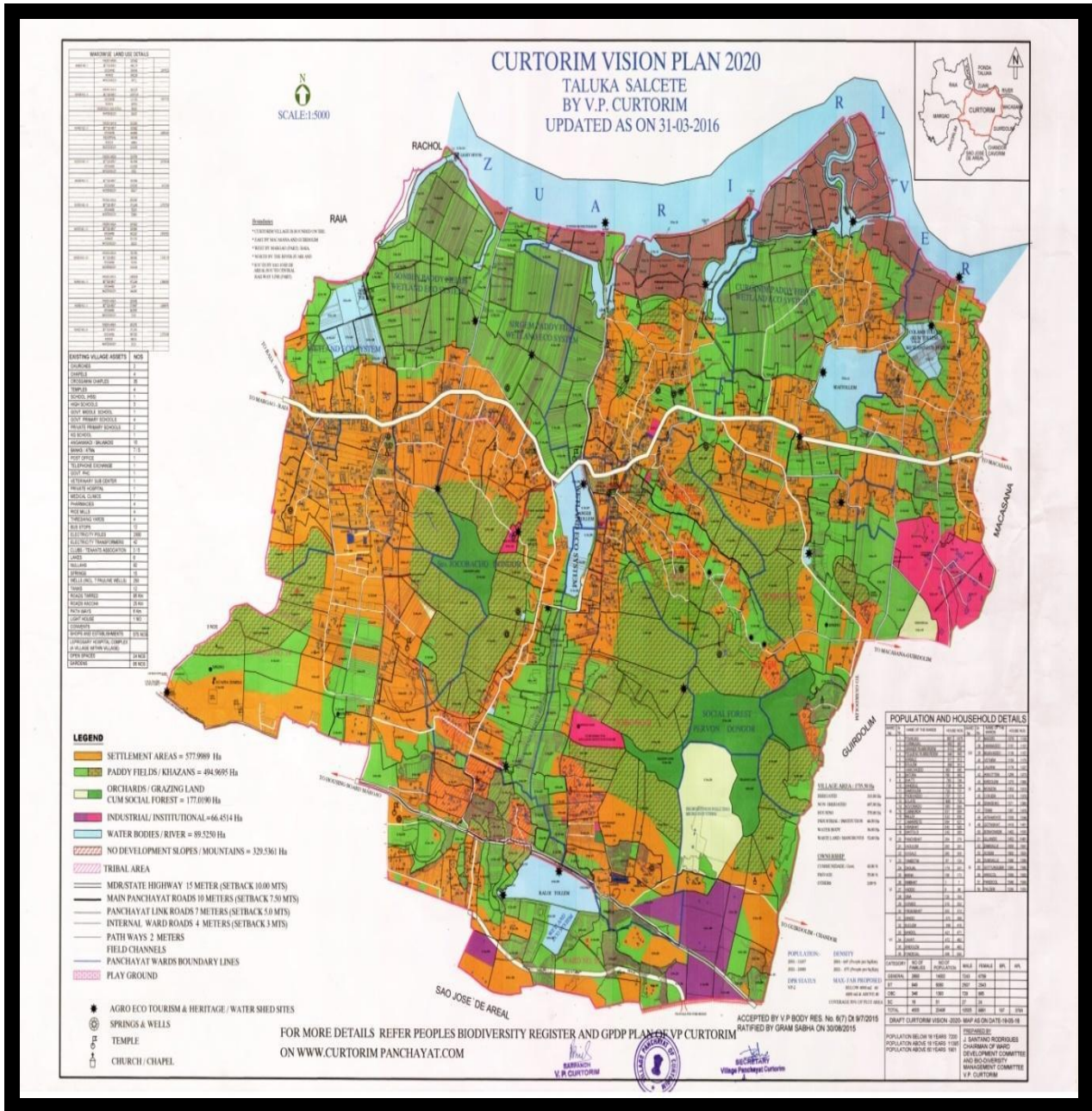

I. INTRODUCTION OF THE VILLAGE OF CURTORIM

The Village Panchayat of Curtorim is situated in the Salcete Taluka of South Goa District. It has a population of 20496 with 10505 males and 9991 female population.

The Panchayat consists of 11 wards and has 06 Male representatives and 05 Female representatives (Total 11 representatives). There are 16 households of SC and 945 households of STs.

The Panchayat has 7 primary schools, at Bhatti, Dagualle, Maina, Bandol, Pandicol, Tembi & Gina.

There are 10 AWC at Cormugal, Cumbora, Novovaddo, Eclate, Virabhat, Dagualle, Bhatti, Maina, Corjem & Agxem with 87 childrens

It has one river, 12 streams and nil waterfalls.

There is one PHC Centre. The distance between the PHC and the Panchayat is 1 Km, the distance between the main hospital and the Panchayat is 9 Kms.

The major source of income for the Curtorim Panchayat is from the house tax, fees, and grant –in- aid and other grants.

Curtorim village is rich in its Natural Resources like Springs, Lakes, Rivers, Hills, Fields, etc, and in its Biodiversity and has intelligent man made historic interventions like bundhs water drains etc.

Let us dream of projecting Curtorim Village as a self-sufficient and model Village for all, without destroying the natural resources, and with a vision “**Niyojit Amcho Gaon, Nitol Amchem Goem / Our Planned Village, Our Clean Goa**”.

FARMERS



Focused group discussion with Farmers

OBSERVATIONS:

Problems

- Construction in Farming Land creates hindrances
- Labour cost is too much & Increasing
- Our own seeds are not produced.
- Due to climate change late flowering of crops is witnessed.
- No proper water and electricity supply.
- Insecticides and pesticides are not provided by the government.
- Wild animals create havoc in fields.
- Barren land issue.
- No labour to carry goods from the farm.
- Lack of knowledge about different schemes in agricultural sector.

SUGGESTIONS:

- Survey of barren land should be conducted.
- Supply of motor for irrigation purpose.
- Solar fencing should be done to avoid wild animals.
- Need of construction of water harvesting unit for irrigation purpose.
- Training on modern farming techniques.
- The Panchayat must make use of the MGNREGA scheme for helping the farmers in the village.
- Increase Government Subsidy. Make the maintenance of machinery free.
- Stop Construction in Farm-Lands

- Grazing ground should be made available by the Panchayat.
- Proper garbage Management system should be created so that garbage is collected regularly so as to avoid cows / buffaloes from eating the same.
- Un-cultivated land may be used to grow fodder.
- Awareness program should be conducted for Milk Producers and Farmers to know their rights & responsibilities along with availability of various schemes from Government.

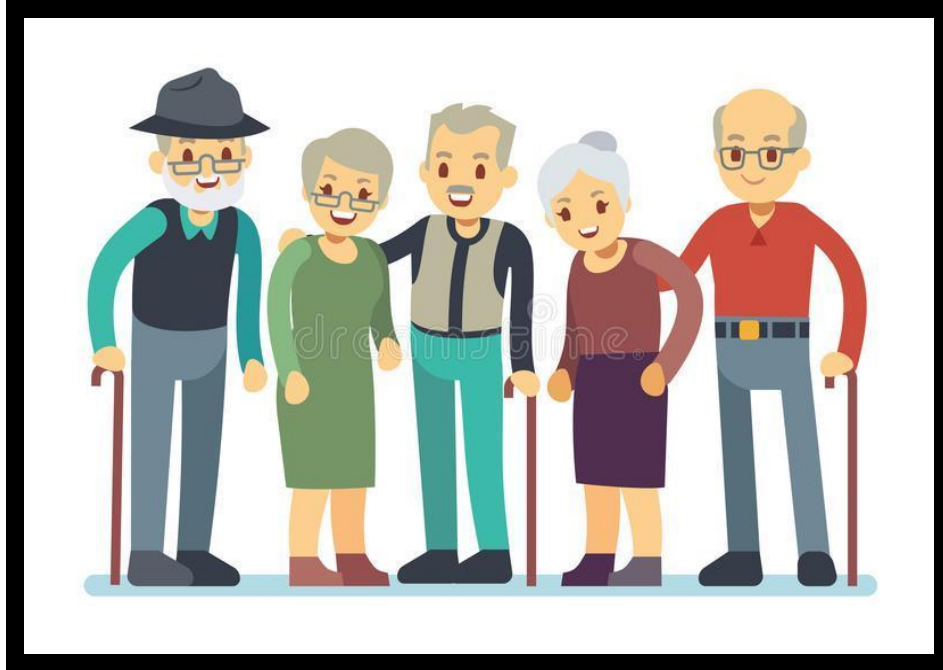
1. Need for Public Library.

Preface

This sector visit was one of the many such visits to various sectors, as part of the program for preparation of the Gram Panchayat Development Plan of the Village Panchayat of Curtorim, Salcete, Goa, which was carried out on 5th 6th & 7th December 2016.

Overview

We met up with Dr. Borkar and the staff of the Primary Health Centre (PHC), who shared with us their concerns and gave us insight into issues and how we can help the PHC and its activities.

Summarized below are the observations and concerns, followed by ways in which they can be helped, which could serve as inputs when drafting the GPDP.

Observations / Concerns

- Regular doctors is not available they should be made available every day.
- Instruments are not available.
- The Village water Sanitation committee should be active.

How the Panchayat can help

- Maintenance and up-keeping of the premises (ongoing basis)
- Prevention of vector borne diseases. For example, by fogging. However, fogging is an activity that needs to be restricted for scientific reasons, and therefore all approvals for fogging should be through the PHC.
- Help with water and sanitation issues. For example, construction soak pits in common places where water / sewage is let out the open by groups of households.
- Help the PHC in their awareness programmers (ongoing basis)

- No storage facilities are available, for office equipment's, sports material and stationary etc.
- All schools do not have compound walls.
- Surrounding of the GPS requires cleaning
- No separate toilets for Girls and Boys.
- Shortage of swings for children.

Suggestions

- Water filters should be provided
- Development of playground is required
- CCTV cameras should be installed in every Government schools.
- Health Checkup must be compulsory every 3 months.
- A Godrej Cupboard should be provided to take care of file – storage.
- Training should be provided to staff on the usage of fire extinguishers and timely replacement should be done.

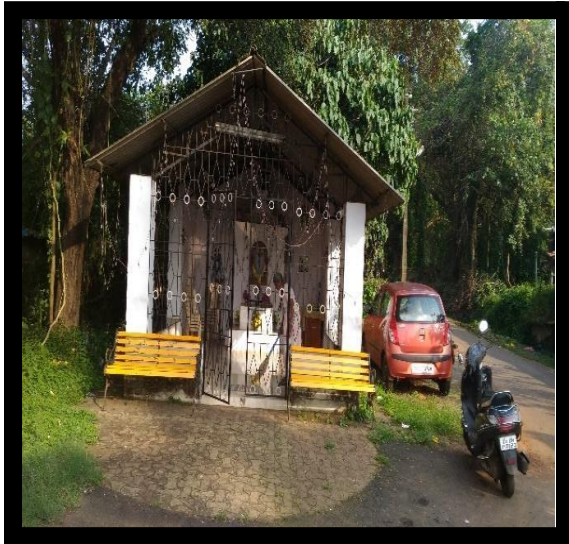

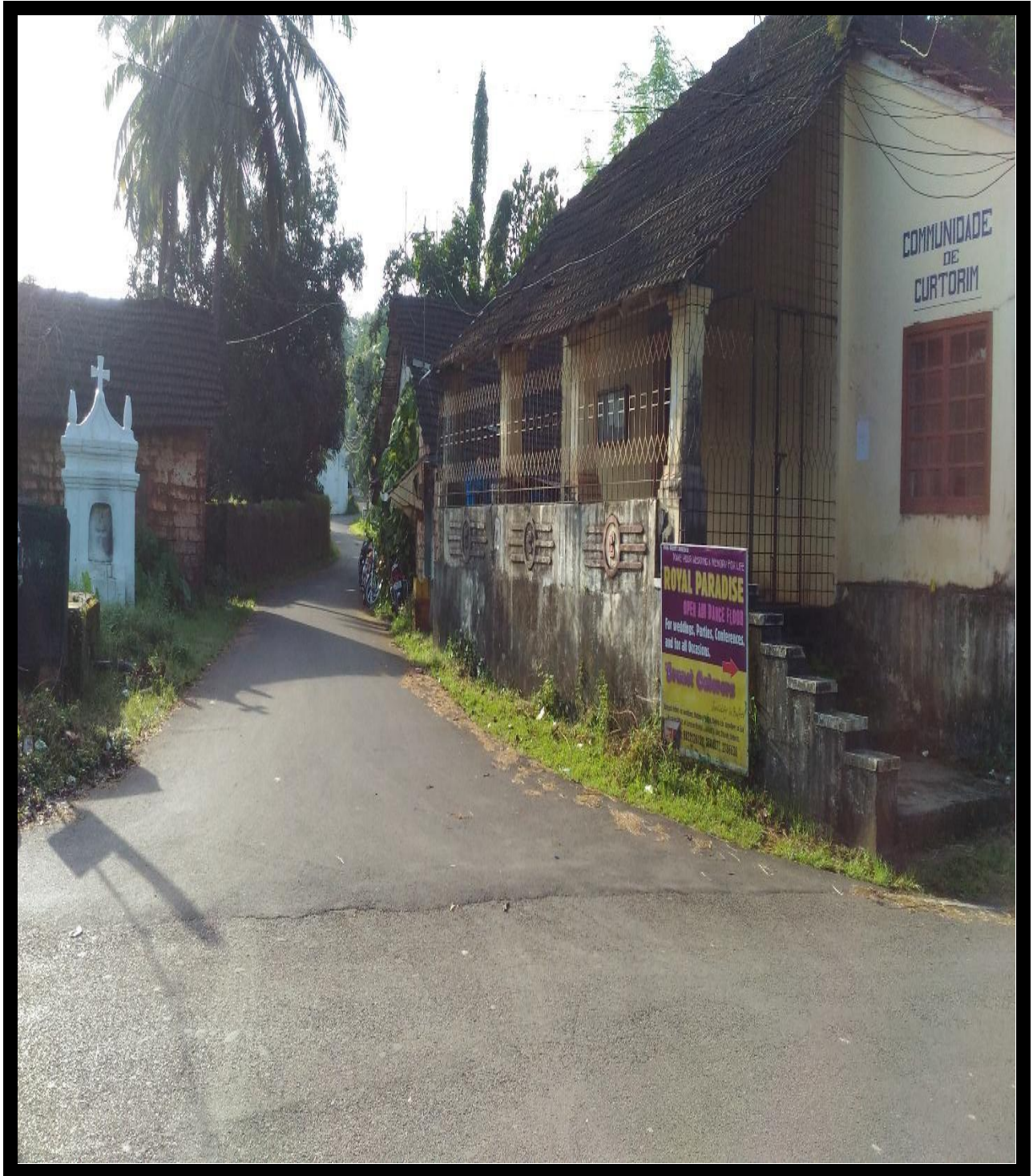
